


POTHOLES BY THE NUMBERS


1. How many pothole service requests are still standing?

As of March 25, 2015, DDOT has 3,672 outstanding service requests for fiscal year 2015.



2. How many have been closed this year?

In 2015, as of March 25, DDOT has filled a little more than 19,000 potholes. See the graphic below to the left with each week from January until March 25.



3. How many potholes have we filled in the past several years during the spring campaign?

Since the start of the Potholepalooza campaign in 2009, DDOT has filled more than 36,000 potholes. The chart and table below show historic data from past Potholepalooza campaigns (2010 through 2014).

4. How many crews (in-house and contract)?

There are 5-8 DDOT (SBM) and 4 DDOT (Asset); 5 Contract employees involved in potholes. DDOT will deploy at maximum strength.

5. How many inspectors are part of our core team?

DDOT has 21 inspections and 10 engineering technicians.
