



Basilica Road Closures & Alternate Routes

2015 Papal Visit: Basilica Closures and Alternate Routes – September 23rd, 2015



- Closures will be in effect surrounding the Catholic University Campus and the Basilica throughout the AM, Midday and PM Rush.
 - Closures will extend east to west from North Capitol Street to John McCormack Drive NE and north to south from Taylor Street NE to Michigan Avenue NE.
 - Taylor Street NE will be closed from North Capitol Street to Hawaii Avenue.
 - Marshall Road NE will be closed from North Capitol Street to Harewood Road.
 - Harewood Road NE will be closed from Michigan Avenue to Taylor Street.
 - 4th Street NE will be closed between Franklin Street and Michigan Avenue
 - Lincoln Road NE will be closed from Franklin Street to 4th Street.
 - North Capitol Street is expected to remain open.

- Michigan Avenue will be closed from Irving Street to 10th Street.
 - Westbound motorists along Michigan Avenue should use southbound 12th Street to westbound Franklin Street to rejoin westbound Michigan Avenue.
 - Eastbound Motorists along Michigan Avenue should use eastbound Franklin Street to northbound 12th Street to rejoin eastbound Michigan Avenue.

- Eastbound Irving Street traffic will not be able to access Michigan Avenue.
 - Traffic should utilize either the northbound or southbound ramps onto North Capitol Street to re-route to their final destinations.

- Northbound ramp from North Capitol Street to Irving Street NE will be closed to all traffic except authorized shuttle buses.

- Local traffic reaching closures surrounding the Basilica will be directed away from the closure by DDOT or MPD forces.
