

Payment Options for DC Student Transit Passes in 2014!

Once you receive your Student DC One Card, you have three fare payment methods:



On-line

Buy DC Student transit passes through Metro's website using a debit or credit card.



- Before you make an on-line purchase, register your DC One Card number at www.dconecard.dc.gov and DC One Card Smartrip number at www.wmata.com/smartrip.


- After registering your card: a) visit WMATA's Smartrip website, b) select your Student DC One Card Smartrip account, c) navigate to "Add Value and Passes" link, and d) choose a DC Student transit pass product.

- **Note: Rail Passes (monthly and 10-trip rail) are available for use after two business days and Bus Passes (10-trip bus) are available after three business days.**

Sales Office

Buy DC Student transit passes at Metro Center, Anacostia Rail Station, Metro Headquarters (Monday through Friday), or at Metro's Northern Division office at 4615 14th Street NW (Saturday, Sunday, and Monday: 8:30 am to 1:00pm)

- Students must present their DC One Card eligibility letter to the Sales Clerk to purchase a transit pass.
- Passes will be ready to use immediately or on the first day of the month.

Renew Monthly Pass

If you prefer to renew the \$30 monthly pass, then tap your student DC One Card on a target on the "Farecards and Passes" machine at a MetroRail Station in DC and follow the instructions to pay and get next month's monthly pass onto your card.

Renewals must take place between the 16th and 30/31 of the current month. Example: To renew a January 2014 monthly pass for February 2014, you must renew at a machine between January 16th and January 31st.
