# DC Student Ride Guide





Students ride free when they just tap and go!



#### Did you know?

Did you know that students age 5 through 21 who are enrolled in DC public school, public charter school or private school can ride Metrobus, Metrorail and DC Circulator to school and school-related activities in DC for FREE?

#### Program Eligibility

To be eligible, students must meet these three qualifications:

- Resident of the District of Columbia
- 2 Age 5 through 21
- Enrolled in an elementary or secondary public, private, charter or parochial school located within the District; or a "Ward of DC" through the Foster Care System.





#### When can you use your card?

- The SmarTrip® card is active on receipt and good until the end of September 2021.
- The card will come pre-loaded with the Kids Ride Free Pass and will be ready to use on Metrorail. Metrobus and DC Circulator.
- The card will be good for the entire school year.



Request a Kids Ride Free SmarTrip® card from your School ID Administrator at your school.



#### How do I use my card?

Tap your Kids Ride Free SmarTrip® card on the faregate or farebox target on Metrorail, Metrobus or DC Circulator. Be sure to tap your Kids Ride Free SmarTrip® card by itself. Flashing the card to ride Metrorail, Metrobus or DC Circulator is never permitted.

#### What if I lose my card?

Request a new Kids Ride Free SmarTrip® card from your School ID Administrator at your school. The lost card will be reported to Metro and will no longer be active. You will not be charged for a replacement Kids Ride Free SmarTrip® card, but must pay regular fare to ride Metrorail, Metrobus and DC Circulator until your new card arrives.

### Can I add value to my Kids Ride Free SmarTrip® card?

No – You cannot add value to your Kids Ride Free SmarTrip® card.

#### When does my old card expire?

Replace your card from the previous school year by the end of September of the current school year.






