accessDC Transportation Study

Background

The District of Columbia Department of Transportation (DDOT) has been awarded an Inclusive Coordinated Transportation Planning grant to work with older residents and people with disabilities to identify ways in which more users can have access to multiple transportation services. Transportation is essential to access health care, social pursuits, and economic opportunities. The grant is funded by the US Administration for Community Living and managed in partnership with the Federal Transit Administration, and is administered by the Community Transportation Association of America (CTAA). Despite current services offered, there are gaps in providing this service to all who need it, and unmet needs exist in the current system. This grant will be used to support the District's efforts to identify those gaps and recommend improvements in transportation services for residents who are older or have disabilities.

Project Goal

The accessDC Study will identify ways to give people with disabilities and older adults in the District of Columbia better access to multiple transportation services, allowing for greater mobility with dignity and independence, and easier integration in the community.

Study Schedule

- Fall 2016: The study will be introduced with kick-off meetings in the community. The team will hold a Project Advisory Council meeting, an Open Mic session, and have stakeholder and customer surveys.
- Winter 2016- 2017: The team will identify existing conditions and hold a second Project Advisory Council meeting.
- Spring 2017: The team will cover the strategies and recommendations for the study. A third Project Advisory Council meeting will be held as well as a second Open Mic Session.
- Early Summer 2017: The project team will produce the final report and hold the last Project Advisory Council meeting.
