



- Class of Action for NEPA
 - Categorical Exclusion (CE)
 - Environmental Assessment (EA)
 - Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)
- Programmatic Agreements
 - Categorical Exclusion
 - Historic Preservation

- Defining the Problem
- Developing Solutions for the Problem
- Analyzing the Impacts
- Avoiding/Minimizing/Mitigating Impacts
- Making Informed Decisions
- Good Documentation (Data, Data, Data!)

moveDC is...


- **Statewide Vision Plan** Mandated by FHWA, similar to what MDOT, VDOT, and other state DOTs produce
- **Local Transportation Plan** like what major cities produce, New York, San Francisco, London, Vancouver
- Blueprint to support future growth District's last long-range plan was in 1997 even as travel has changed radically


16th Street, NW Transit Priority Planning Study

- Develop Preliminary Engineering Conceptual Drawings to Address Technical Details

- Complete 12 months after Notice to Proceed






DC Streetcar (North-South Corridor) Schedule and Process



Purpose and Need

To evaluate reliable and comprehensive improved transit services along the North-South Corridor to enhance current transit service and to support existing neighborhoods and future growth in and along the corridor.

- . Provide improved North-South surface transit connectivity
- . Improve transit reliability and decrease transit travel times
- · Increase transit capacity and person throughput
- · Increase transit mode share in the corridor
- Improve transit stop and vehicle accessibility for limited mobility users

DC Streetcar (North-South Corridor) Findings



- Georgia Avenue experiences moderate travel delay
- 7th Street experiences more significant travel delay
- Bus speeds vary significantly
- Bus service experiences bunching
- Current bus ridership is significant and growing
- Future travel conditions may experience significant delay
- Ridership projections for the north segment are robust

 - ✓ Bus, car, bike, pedestrian
- Transform Corridor with New Streetscape
 - ✓ ADA compliant sidewalk, tree, street features





Green Infrastructure (GI) & Low Impact Development (LID)


- Reduce Stormwater Runoff from streets, sidewalks, and alleys using green infrastructure
- District Stormwater Regulations (2013) require retention of 1.2 inches of runoff
- Retrofit projects Green Alleys & sites citywide (primarily Separated Sewer Area)
- DDOT Green Infrastructure Standards
- ddot.dc.gov/GreenInfrastructure






Green Infrastructure (GI) Practices

Permeable Pavement









Landscaped Medians/Green Spaces/Tree Services Ward Based

Goals:

- Support and enhance storm water capture rates from the Districts streets as mandated by EPA in the MS 4 permit
- Tree Boxes shall be maintained by the abutting owner as per the DCMR 24
- Street Trees are maintained by the UFA ISA certified arborist and services should be requested through the Mayor Call Center at 311
- Landscape/green spaces enhance the neighborhood and provide traffic calming <u>Schedule</u>

Ward 1 Tree Planting

Goals:

- Support and enhance community livability
- Satisfy federally-mandated stormwater management consent decree (MS4 Permit)
- Deliver environmental services
 - ✓ Cleaner air Cleaner water
- To calm traffic
- To beautify neighborhoods!

Status:

- This fall and spring UFA will install over 300 trees in ward 1 – Ward 1 is 97% planted!
- DDOT's planting season will start in October and will continue through April


Streetlight Upgrades Ward 1


Goals:

- Install More Efficient LED Fixtures
 - ✓ Reduces power cost
 - ✓ Better lighting uniformity
 - ✓ Long lasting/low maintenance

Status:

- T Street Lighting Upgrade (7th to 11th Street, NW) – Complete End of October
 - ✓ Replaced 11 pendant poles with 400W HPS inefficient lights with 21 efficient 100W LED lights on #16 poles
- Design On Spot Light Under Trees on Vermont Avenue, NW (between U and T Street) – Complete
 - ✓ Upgrade 20 inoperable spot lights with 25W LEDs
