

# DC KIDS RIDE **New** FREE ON METRO RAIL

**Go online** and enroll for your **free Metrorail pass**. Public school students may enroll in the program starting **August 17th**. The pass will be loaded onto your DC One Card.

- STEP 1:** Make sure you have a DC One Card. Go to [dconecard.dc.gov](http://dconecard.dc.gov) to find out how to get one or ask at your school.
- STEP 2:** Make sure you **REGISTER** your DC One Card. Go to [dconecard.dc.gov/manage](http://dconecard.dc.gov/manage) and register your card.
- STEP 3:** Once you have a DC One Card and it's registered, go to [dconecard.dc.gov/manage](http://dconecard.dc.gov/manage) and sign in with an email address and **CLICK** the eligibility button under **TRANSIT SUBSIDY SECTION**.

**3 Easy Steps!**  
Complete these steps and  
in 24 hours you can tap  
your card to ride for free.

## FACTS:

- May be used for travel to and from school and school-related events.
- Available to DC students, ages 5-21, who attend a DC public school (DCPS) or public charter school (PCS); kids under 5 are already eligible to ride the Metrorail for free.
- Available throughout the year as long as you are enrolled in a DC public school (DCPS) or public charter school (PCS).
- Tap your DC One Card on the Metrorail faregate; flashing the card to the Station Manager is not acceptable.
- Don't forget about the **Kids Ride Free Bus** program. Visit [ddot.dc.gov](http://ddot.dc.gov) for program details.
