








DETAIL PLAN- FRONT DESK, OFFICE, RESTROOMS & LOCKERS












DETAIL PLAN - KITCHEN

















DESIGN PROCESS







COMMUNITY MEETING RESULTS- OCTOBER 2, 2014





On October 2, 2014, residents of Kenilworth attended the design charette to determine the look and the feel for the recreation center. Around 30 residents voted on 5 of the visual preference images above to help architects understand the character of the exterior and interior spaces.

The common themes displayed in the charette are as following:

- Outdoor activity space for community events.
- Trellis with landscape elements at the entrance.
- Combination of clear and translucent glass panels for the gymnasium.
- Combination of leisure and activity pools for the pool configuration.
- Green roofs and green wall in the building.
